For over 10 years, AUP has been a 'sister' in My Sister's House providing funding and assistance to the organization.

My Sister's House is one of two facilities supported by the Atlanta Union Mission organization. My Sister's House is a crisis shelter and a long-term residential recovery program for women and children along with a therapeutic child development center.

My Sister's House provides emergency food, clothing, shelter and referrals to homeless women and their children. In addition to the emergency shelter, the center offers single women an opportunity to enter a comprehensive recovery program. Opened in 1969, My Sister's House was the first shelter for women in Atlanta.
