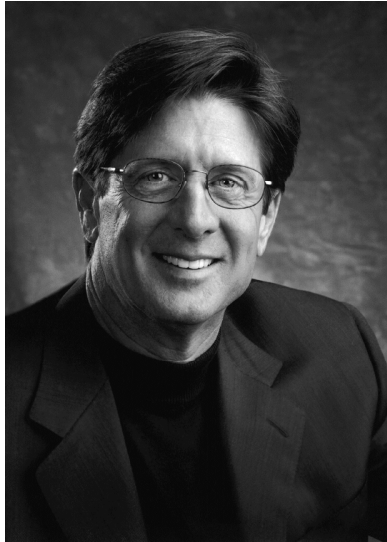


Greg Jordan

The Silver Medal Award recognizes significant contributions to the community, the advertising industry, and a commitment to excellence in their company, and is presented by the Advertising Federation of Greater Hampton Roads.

Among Jordan’s accomplishments is Teagle & Little’s receipt of the Printing Industry of Virginia’s (PIVA) “Best of Show” eight times in 12 years.

During his tenure as president, the company has grown from a quality local print shop into an internationally recognized concern with clients that rank among some of the world’s best-known brands including Ralph Lauren, Coca-Cola, and Audi.

While leading this rapidly expanding company, Jordan also served on the Old Dominion University’s (ODU) Intercollegiate Athletic Foundation Board of Directors; developed a Printing Industries Intern Program with Chowan College and ODU; served on the Ad Club (AAF) of Hampton Roads Board of Directors; served on the fundraising committee for the American Heart Association; active on the Graphics Arts Trade Foundation; and was a coach in the Great Neck Athletic Association Recreation Baseball League.
